

Tent Pegging Rider Level one

At that level, the Rider should have knowledge of Tent Pegging skills, and Equestrian skills as following

Tent Pegging skills

The Rider should be able to do Sword/Lance drill on foot	The Rider should be able to define Tent Pegging as an equestrian game
The rider should be able to perform the drill mounting at walk stride	The Rider should have General knowledge about the ITPF & TPF Canada
How to discard Sword/ Lance in individual Runs	The Rider should know How to score in individual runs
The rider should know How to handle the equipment in a safe way (Safety Positions)	

Equestrian skills	
Practical	Theoretical
The rider should be able to trot on his own with one hand	The rider should be able to identify horse colors and markings
The rider should be able to perform 2 point in trot	The rider should have a good knowledge regarding parts of the horse
The rider should be able to tack/ groom the horse on his own	
Cooling down/warming up the horse	

To obtain the badge for that level the rider should have at least TPF Canada Bronze membership and go through a written exam, and a practical assessment
